Many of you will be aware that the teaching of Relationship Education was made statutory by the government last year. Primary schools were directed to introduce Relationship Education from September 2020. However, due to Covid restrictions, the deadline for the introduction of Relationship Education into the curriculum was delayed to the Summer Term 2021.

We have drafted our Relationship Education Policy and Curriculum in line with our ethos and Islamic teachings. A staff consultation has already taken place and the Draft Policy was submitted for approval to our Trust.

We are now submitting our RE Draft Policy to all parents for consultation. We have uploaded the Draft Policy along with our PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education) Curriculum Map on our website for your consideration.

We invite you to read through the document and the associated PSHE Curriculum; we would then ask for your feedback by completing an online survey. The link to the survey will be sent separately via text message.

The Parent Consultation will close on **Friday 4th December**.

The outcome of the survey will be taken into consideration before finalising the Draft Policy and re-submitting it to the trust for ratification.
