## COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

This term we are learning vocabulary used in books when looking at “Traditional Tales”.

This will include retelling stories using repeated phrases, anticipating and predicting what happens next, and sequencing the stories.

New vocabulary will also be covered in Maths and Islamic Studies

Story times will help the children to improve on their listening and attention skills.



## PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

The children will be learning ball skills this term.

This includes throwing and catching in the air.

Next will be throwing and catching with a partner.

We will also do lots of fine motor skills practise – writing, colouring and making models using dough.

## PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

The children will be doing a lot of circle time games – and this involves sharing and taking turns.

We will talk about feelings – what makes us happy? What makes us sad?

What can we do if we feel angry? - also from an Islamic perspective.

Surah Al-Ikhlaas and al-Kawthar

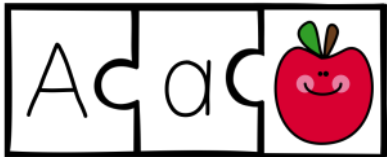
**Revision:** Surah Al-Fatihah
