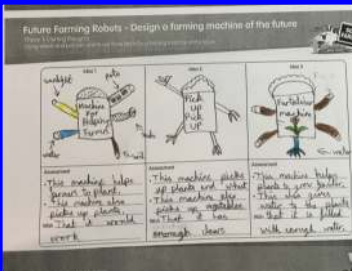
Mrs Benashur spoke about the theme of innovation for Science Week and learning about past inventors to inspire us to innovate for the future.

Year 3 designed their own robots that they thought would be useful on a farm.



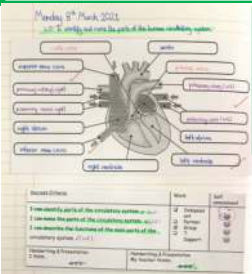
Reception learned about the life cycle of a chicken, watching a live lesson with a chick hatching.



We found a frog near our pond.

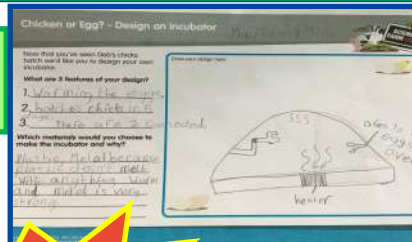


Key Stage 2 had a workshop about Future Farming Robots.
