**Re: Ramadan Provision**

I hope this letter finds you in good health and strong Imaan.

As stated in last week's letter sent by our Executive Head Teacher, Mrs Mohamed, school will start at the later time of 10:00 am during Ramadan.

Ramadan drop off timings will be staggered as follows:

KS2 (Yr3 – Yr6)	9:40 am – 9:50 am
EYFS (R & Nursery), KS1 (Yr1&Yr2)	9:50 am – 10:00 am

As in previous years, we will offer provision from 8:30 am for working parents who are not able to drop off their child/ren at the later time.

This presents a challenge this year, as in line with COVID health and safety measures, pupils are in bubbles and do not mix freely.

We therefore need to know in advance, how many pupils will need morning supervision so that bubble arrangements and staff supervision can be planned accordingly.
