## COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

During circle time, pupils will be encouraged to share their experiences and opinions and to listen to their friends. We will try to notice the differences and similarities between their personal and family experiences to those of their peers and children interviewed or characters in books. Topics of conversation will include:

- How they are celebrating Ramadan and Eid
- Journeys they have taken and where they would like to travel to in the future
- Vehicles they have used or are keen to travel on when they are older.

Reception will encounter new vocabulary such as terms like 'the exhaust' and expand their knowledge of vehicle names and places they could visit.

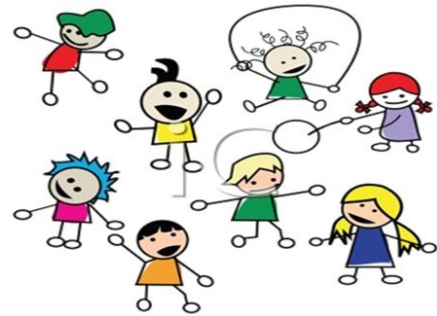
In roleplay situations inside and outside they will be encouraged to use technical vocabulary to make their pretend play seem more realistic.

## PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Reception will be performing acts of kindness in relation to their daily Ramadan challenges.
- Compare and contrast opinions, family traditions and show tolerance for others.
- Learn how to work in a group by listening to other's opinions and caring about their friends' feelings.

## PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Reception pupils will be supported to become more proficient riders of the school bikes and wheeled vehicles.
- [At home they should set themselves a new target and endeavour to become more confident using e.g. a scooter, balance bike or pedal bike.]
- Reception will also practise using balls and participate in group games using balls.
- In gymnastic lessons they will be focusing on using the large equipment and learning to travelling in a variety of ways. climb, dismount and hold balances inspired by vehicles.



## QURAN



**Memorisation:** Surah al-Humazah

**Revision:** all previous surahs including Quraish and al-Fil

**Reading:** reading two-letter words with fatha, Dammah and Kasra.

## ISLAMIC STUDIES

- Ramadan moon—a special month
- Sahoor and Iftar

## LITERACY

- We will be reading some wonderful books about fantastical journey's such as the Quest, and children's classics like Mr Grumpy's outing.
- Pupils will be encouraged to join in with repeated phrases, retell stories and think of possible extra additional pages/storylines.
- We will also read non-fiction texts about a variety of vehicles and label parts of our favourite modes of transport.



## MATHEMATICS

- Pupil will continue to practise reading and writing numerals, adding and subtracting.
- Reception will learn to count forwards and backwards in 10s to 100 [and those who are already confident in this skill will begin learning how to count in tens from any given number.]
- We will continue learning about shapes focusing on describing their qualities.
- Reception will also continue to enhance their understanding of money.

## PHONICS

We will continue our Phase 3 phonics by learning 2 letter sounds [digraphs] e.g. 'er' [rubber, dinner] and 3 letter sounds [trigraphs] such as 'ear' e.g. beard. They will read and write captions and sentences.



## EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

- We will be making Ramadan/Eid and transport inspired art such as moon mobiles we can hang in the classroom, vehicles and maps, and roleplaying going on real and fantastical journeys.
- We will also be inspired by favourite stories such as 'Rosie Revere' and 'The magic bed' to invent our own vehicles.

## UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Reception will learn about:

- Floating and sinking.
- Humans can change their environment e.g. by Polluting or causing habitats or animals to become endangered.
