MATHEMATICS

Four operations

We will revise the use of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division in solving problems. We will challenge ourselves by looking at problems that involve more than one operation.



Geometry

We will revise the recognition of angles, particularly angles within shapes. We will also revise how to find the perimeter of shapes.

Time

We will revisit telling the time and look at how we can use a number line to solve problems involving time.

ENGLISH

Non-Fiction

We will explore the features of a newspaper report before writing our own. We will discuss the various language and structural features present, drawing upon the purpose of each feature.

Grammar

We will revise the use of formal/informal language, direct/indirect speech and how to use effective sentence openers in a newspaper report.

ART

Our Insects unit will teach Year 3 about how to use pencil, colour, mosaic design, puppet making and sculpture to create quality artwork that shows progression in their skills. The children will also have the opportunity to explore the work of a range of 'Insect' artists, in particular, Louise Bourgeois and Jennifer Angus.

PSHE

This half term, we are exploring the theme 'Money Matters'. This unit aims to encourage children to think about where money comes from and how it can be used. Children will discuss how we spend money, why people might need to borrow money and the consequences of this. Children will begin to explore how we can prioritise what we spend and what choices we have.



SCIENCE & HUMANITIES

In our Science 'Light' unit, we will explore light, reflections and shadows. Children will learn about different sources of light, and that we need light to see. The children will work scientifically and collaboratively to investigate reflective materials. The children will have a chance to test which objects are opaque, and will find out how shadows change when the distance between the object and light source changes.

In our Humanities topic, children will learn about the coast of the British Isles. Children will consider some of the advantages and disadvantages of living by the coast. Throughout the unit, they will also be introduced to some contrasting coasts around the world, extending their coastal and locational knowledge.

COMPUTING

Computer Components: This half term students learn about computer components and their function. They will be able to interactive-ly build own programmable machine.
