## MATHEMATICS

### Place Value

Counting, sorting and representing objects.

Count, read and write forwards and backwards from any number 0 to 10.

Count one more and one less.

Compare groups/numbers using language such as equal, more/greater, less/fewer.

Introduce  $<$ ,  $>$  and  $=$  symbols.

Order numbers from smallest to biggest.

### Number: Addition and Subtraction

Introduce the addition and subtraction symbols.

Part-whole model.

Number fact families.

Number bonds within 10 and to 10.

## ENGLISH

### Non-Fiction: Who Lives Here?

The children will explore the interactive eBook *Who Lives Here?*, linking the text to their own experiences. They will use maps to recall the sequence and ask questions about events in the eBook. They will learn about different uses for capital letters and use these in their writing. The writing tasks involve composing factual sentences about animals and writing a nature diary.

### Poetry

The children will use their senses to explore the weather, mud and the playground as they enjoy listening to a range of poetry. They will come up with new vocabulary and sound effects and use real and invented words to describe what they feel - linking it all to their own experiences. They will construct sentences to describe how things feel and sound. They will finally create short narratives and poems.

### Grammar

- How words combine to make a sentence.
- Demarcation of sentences
- Key sentence structure terminology e.g. full stops, capital letters

## SCIENCE

### Science: Seasonal Changes: Autumn & Winter

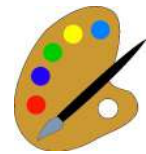
This unit will teach the four seasons, with a particular focus on autumn and winter. Children will learn what the word weather means and find out how different types of weather can be measured. Children will use a class weather station to observe measure and record the weather across the seasons. They will also observe changes across the seasons by exploring the signs of autumn and winter through nature and wildlife. A range of learning activities are used in this unit including observation, discussion and learning outside. Children also work scientifically by collecting, recording and interpreting simple data.

## HUMANITIES

### What is it like where we live?

This unit will develop locational knowledge based on the view from the school and local walks. The children will learn differences between map, plan and aerial photographs. They will be able to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features. Throughout the unit, children will learn and use locational and directional language to describe the location of features and routes on a map.

## ART



### Autumn

In this unit, the children will learn how to use pencil, colour, paint, print, collage and paper to create quality art work that shows progression in skills. The children will also have the opportunity to explore the work of several paintings of Autumn scenes, also works by Matisse and by Cezanne.

## PSHE

### Aiming High

Children will learn about having high aspirations. They will start by discussing positive views of themselves and will then identify how having a positive learning attitude can help them tackle and achieve new learning challenges and improve learning outcomes. Through this learning, different jobs and roles will be considered.

## PE

### Running and Jumping

Learn to travel at different speeds by walking, jogging, running and sprinting, and develop an understanding of when these speeds are most useful. Explore different ways of jumping and apply these skills to jumping games and create jumping sequences. Learn the importance of landing steadily.



## COMPUTING

### Computer Skills

Learn how to use a mouse/ trackpad and launch applications, manipulate windows and open/save files. Know how to start and shut down a computer.
