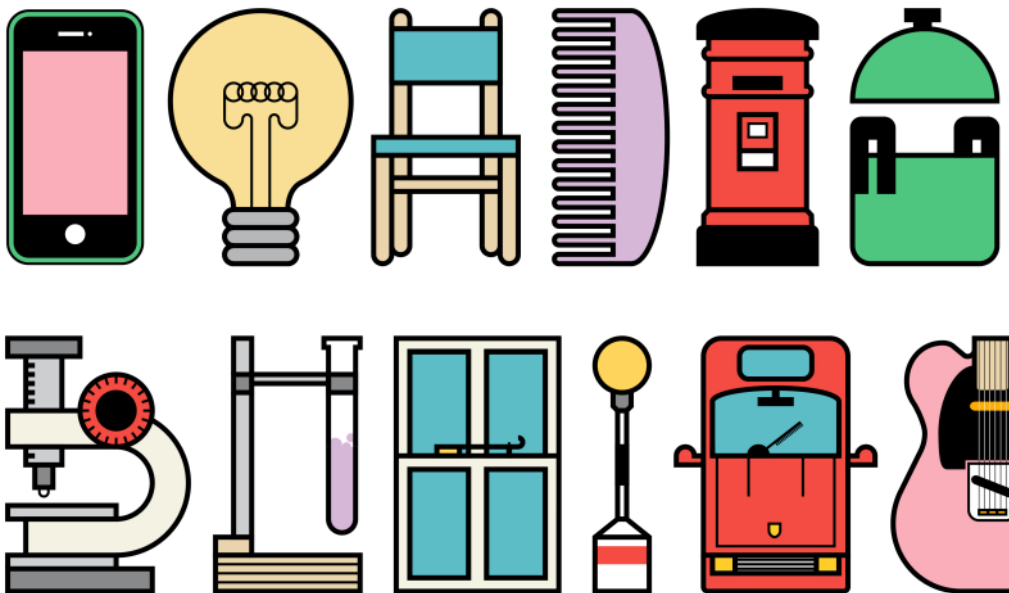

MATHEMATICS

Four Operations: Types of Numbers

After a brief recap of long division, we will revise common factors and multiples of larger numbers. Then prime numbers, squares and cubes will be explored before moving onto order of operations and using known facts to perform mental calculations.

Fractions

The children will compare, order and simply fractions to find equivalences. They will then begin to use all four operations when working with different fraction amounts and use reasoning to understand and solve worded fraction problems.

Geometry: Position and Direction

We will be working in the four quadrants to translate and reflect different coordinates and polygons. There will be a focus on being able to find missing coordinates and some focus on using mirrors for reflections.



ENGLISH

Fiction: Fantastic, Funny, Frightening

The children explore and compare style in different genres. They will read a book together to develop their understanding of author's language choice, and finally write and publish their own suspense story for younger readers, which will be shared with other classes!



Non-Fiction: Amazing Inventions

The children will try to answer the big question: 'What do you think the greatest invention is?' After retrieving facts, participating in debates, and designing their own invention, they will write an informative article with their final answer.

Grammar

There will be revision of different types of clauses and the importance of cohesion. We will progress onto looking at subject and object placement in sentences and using advanced punctuation such as colon, semi colons and hyphens.

SCIENCE & HUMANITIES

Science: In this 'Electricity' unit, children will learn **to represent circuits using symbols** in a diagram. They will learn about two of the **most important scientific inventors** in the field of electricity – Thomas Edison and Nikola Tesla. Children will get the opportunity to develop their understanding of what electricity is and **how to measure it**. They will **conduct their own investigation**; planning, recording and conclusion skills will be revised in depth.

Humanities: In this History unit, we will explore the history of **World War 2** and answer the question, 'how did it impact our local area?'. They will learn about why it began; the countries involved and discover all about evacuation and how this might have felt for the people involved. By the end of the unit, the children will be able to recall some key events from the war, organise information chronologically and recognise how past events have shaped the world as we know it.

COMPUTING

Google sites - Pupils will create their own Google website. Pupils will learn how to use various commands and features in order to bring to life their website.

Super Seasonal Cooking

Linking with PSHE, the children will learn about **the importance of buying seasonal food and understanding where, when and how** a variety of ingredients are grown, reared, caught, and processed.

They will sample some seasonal food and then design their own balanced seasonal meal before preparing and cooking it using **strict hygiene rules for safe preparation skills**.
