## Year 6 Newsflash

We received the Year 6 SATs results yesterday and masha'Allah, they are excellent.

Expected standard is achieved when a pupil has a scaled score between 100 and 120 and **all of our Year 6 pupils, i.e. 100%**, met the expected standard in each of the tested subjects / areas - English Reading, Spelling/Grammar and Punctuation and Mathematics. Nationally, 59% achieved expected standard.

The average scaled score our pupils achieved was 110-112 across the board – again a fabulous achievement.

We are very proud of them. These are the first key stage 2 attainment results since 2019, after assessment was cancelled in 2020 and 2021 due to the pandemic. Our pupils experienced disruption to their learning during the pandemic, particularly at the end of Year 4 and in Year 5. It is therefore an even greater achievement.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all our teachers for their hard work with our pupils during remote teaching, our parents for supporting their children's remote learning and Mrs Fiaz, our Year 6 teacher, who worked very hard with her pupils this year to ensure that gaps were closed. Well done, Year 6!
